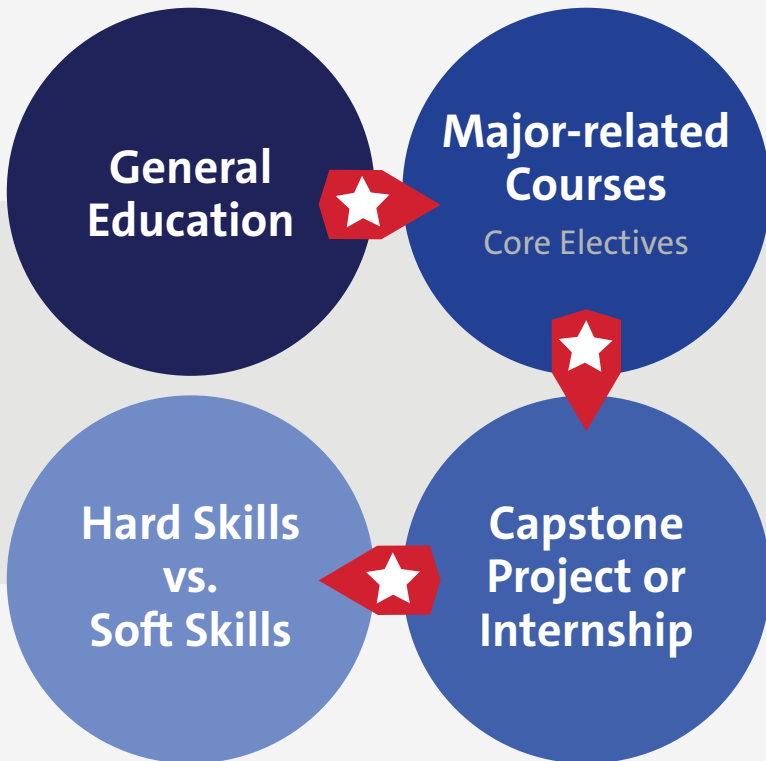


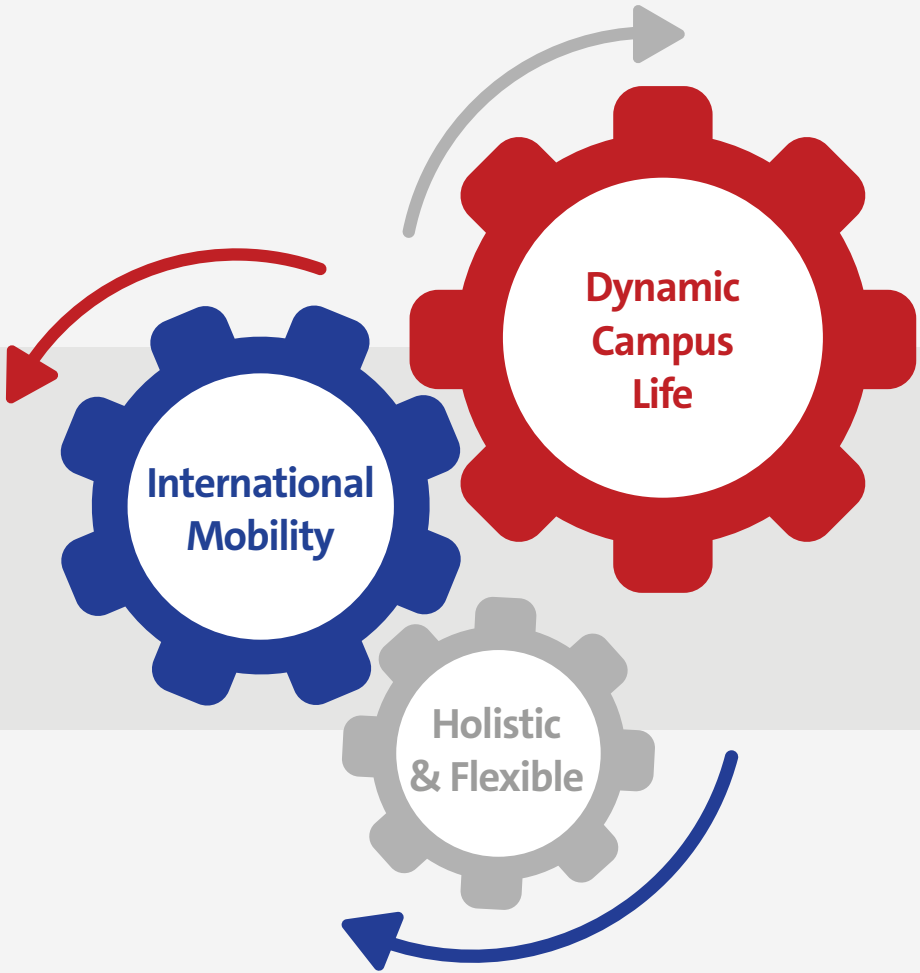

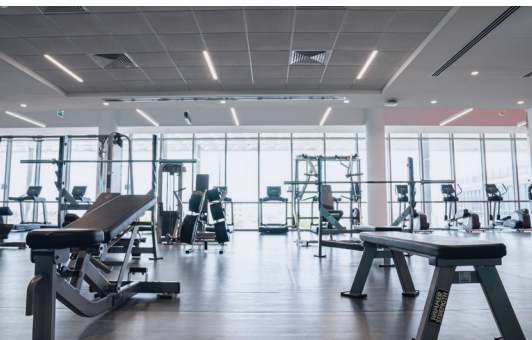

Types of Admissions



Full Admission

Applicants who met the University's entry requirements and submitted their complete documents to the Office of Admissions will receive a Full Admission letter.



Conditional Admission

Applicants who have not submitted their complete documents to the Office of Admissions may be admitted on a conditional basis and will receive a Conditional Admission letter **until all documents are received**. Students will not be permitted to enroll in classes until all the required documents are submitted to the Office of Admissions before the last day for class registration.



Provisional Admission

Applicants who **do not meet full admission requirements but show potential for academic success** at the University level may be admitted on a provisional basis. These admitted students are required to follow stipulations outlined in a Provisional Admission letter and **may be enrolled in the University Preparatory Program**. The University works closely with provisionally admitted students to develop a plan for meeting the required stipulations and achieving full admission status. Students typically remain under provisional admittance status for one semester or **up to one year**. A regular student status can be obtained after meeting the full admission criteria.

Language	English language proficiency such as IELTS (Academic) with a score of (6.0 IELTS) or equivalent such as TOEFL or Duolingo.
Interview	Passing AUBH personal interview (if applicable).

Required Documents

To formally be admitted to the University, you will need to provide the following original documents or proof of pending results:

- Statement of graduation / high school diploma
- High school transcripts: Semesters 1 to 6 (government schools) Grades 9-12 (private schools)
- An equivalency letter from the Ministry of Education
- English language proficiency such as IELTS (academic) or TOEFL
- Passport copy
- CPR copy / National ID
- A medical report from a public health center or an approved private hospital
- High-resolution passport-size photograph (soft copy)

****Note:** If you have studied abroad, please make sure that your high school transcript and statement of graduation receive the necessary stamps from the embassy or Ministry of Foreign Affairs for attestation.*

Scholarships



The American University of Bahrain grants scholarships to students with exemplary academic performance, personal achievements, and motivation to succeed. They are also seen as ambassadors of the AUBH mission and vision, who thrive within a diverse and multicultural student body. The scholarships we offer students include full scholarships, partial scholarships, and need-based scholarships.

1 Full Scholarships

This scholarship covers books and tuition fees for four academic years.

Criteria for Application

- GPA 90% +.
- IELTS of 6 with no less than 5.5 in writing or equivalent.
- Bahraini national.

Documents Required

- School transcript.
- Valid proof of English language proficiency.
- Personal statement.
- Portfolio of achievement.

Selection

- Students will be requested to take a problem-solving test on campus.
- Short-listed students will then be invited to an online panel interview.



2 Partial Scholarships

This scholarship scheme is for domestic students only.

a) Early Enrollees Award

This award is guaranteed for those who enroll by the specified deadline. However, if the recipient qualifies for and received a higher value scholarship, the early Enrollees award will no longer apply.

b) Academic Excellence Award

Scholarships are granted based on a student's high school GPA.

c) Inspire, Lead, and Compete Award

This award is for exceptional skills or achievements in specific fields. Students must submit their portfolio and undergo an interview process.

3 International Scholarships

This scholarship scheme is for international students only, coming from outside of Bahrain.

4 Financial Aid

AUBH offers different financial aid options for students.

Financial Regulations

Students must comply with the financial regulations of the University. Students are expected to settle their tuition and fees as per the payment deadlines.

Payment Deadlines

University students are required to pay their tuition and fees based on the below due dates:

Late Registration

University students must adhere to registration deadlines. Registration of courses must be no later than the published dates in the academic calendar. Registration during or after the Add/Drop period is subject to a Late Registration Fee.

Late Payments

University students must adhere to payment deadlines. Payments completed after the deadline for each installment is subject to a Late Payment Fee

Outstanding Balances

Students with outstanding balances or financial obligations will:

- Not be able to **access the learning management systems.**
- Not be able to **view their grades.**
- Not be eligible to **register** for the following term.
- Not be able to **get transcripts, grades, graduation/completion letters and certifications.**
- Not be able to **obtain Finance approval** required for processing various forms.

Refund Policy

Dropping/Withdrawing from Courses:

In the event a student drops a course during the add/drop period, the student will be refunded 100% of the paid tuition and fees for the course as long as the student maintains the minimum credit hours for the semester. Non-attendance of classes does not imply that the student has dropped the course, and the tuition and fees will be applicable. In the event a student withdraws from a course after the add/drop period, the student will not be refunded for the tuition and fees of the course.

Withdrawing from the Semester/University:

In the event a student chooses to completely withdraw from the university or a semester, the following refund schedule will apply for the tuition and fees excluding the non-refundable fees and deposits:

Installment Plans

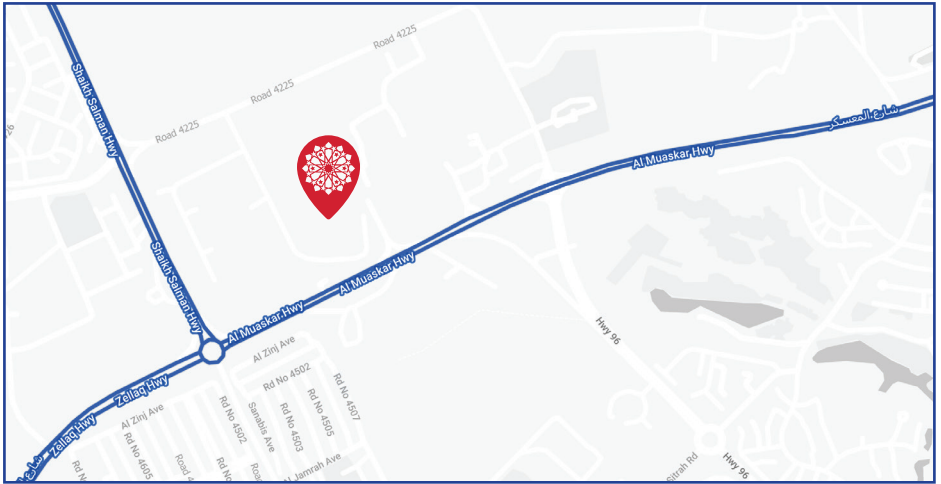

AUBH's MBA, co-created with the Dean and Faculty from California State University Northridge's David Nazarian College of Business and Economics, can accelerate a corporate career path or lay the foundation for the next tech startup, in both cross-regional and global markets. This degree is widely applicable across all industries; exploring the latest global business trends, the newest management tools and techniques, and challenging students to improve networks and collaboration.

Program Content

Our MBA program reinforces business fundamentals through a strong foundation of accounting, marketing and strategy. As students move through the two years, they master skills in leadership, creating partnerships, interpreting industry data, managing crises and negotiation techniques. Students then progress to chosen electives like International Business and Entrepreneurship and Innovation. Finally, led by supportive and practiced mentors, students complete a thesis paper on a subject that they find compelling, relating specifically to the field they want to pursue.



Who Should Apply?

This two-year degree program is an exciting choice for anyone looking to take an existing career to the next level, or for recent graduates to hone their business and management skills. In an economy characterized by intense competition, technological change and rapid growth of globalization, students with an MBA-level qualification and credentials will have the edge in career opportunities. An MBA is broad enough to be applicable to multiple sectors, while providing specific skills for management and real-world challenges. AUBH's MBA shows students how to blaze their own paths, whether it leads them to the C-Suite, entrepreneurship or teaching businesses to thrive.

Program Content

This two-year program begins with core classes focusing on management; Financial and Managerial Accounting, Project Management, Managing People and Organizations and Strategic Technology Management. After completing core modules, students focus their skills by choosing elective courses in line with specialist areas of interest, for example Product Design & Innovation, or Ethics, Sustainability and Corporate Governance. To complement this, students have the opportunity to complete a thesis that supports their particular learning path, supported by practiced mentors. Graduates of the Master of Science in Engineering Management will be prepared for the next phase of their career, with specialist knowledge of engineering management theories, methods, practices and strategies.

Mid and senior level professionals who are looking to strengthen their credentials as C-Level executives, administrators and consultants. This program is for engineers who are passionate about their work and want to build on their existing portfolio and skillset. Delving deeper, students can then complete an individual thesis with the help of experienced mentors. By the time a student completes this degree, they are ready to take on challenging roles across growing industries including media, advertising, video game design, web design, television, and more.

Free thinkers who want to create original concepts, animations, and artworks, and lead teams. This two-year degree program is for anyone who wants to elevate their career in the fields of advertising, media, fine art, marketing, or public relations, or for any existing professional looking to shift to a multimedia managerial career. 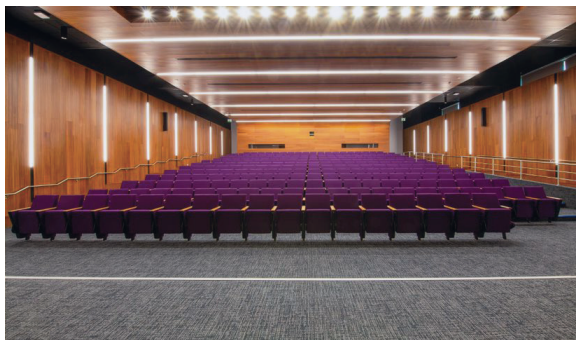
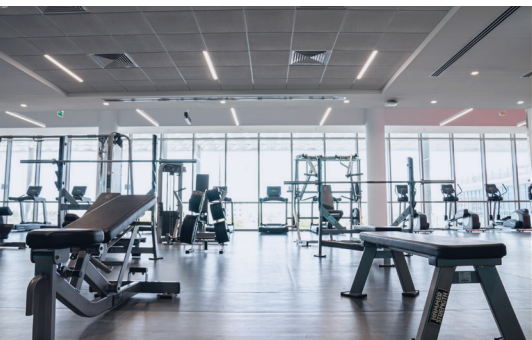

Admissions Process

College of Media & Design

Master of Arts in Multimedia Management (M.A.)

Degree & GPA	Bachelor's degree from an accredited institution of higher education in media, multimedia, or business; or other bachelor's degrees with work experience in media, advertising, marketing, or public relations with a minimum GPA of 2.5 out of 4.0 (or equivalent).
Language	English language proficiency score of 6.5 in the IELTS test or equivalent. Applicants progressing from universities where the medium of instruction is English and where students are required to provide proof of English language proficiency upon entry may be exempted from this requirement.
Interview	Passing AUBH personal interview (if applicable).
Research Methods	Candidates are expected to have completed a research methods course during their previous degrees. However, those who cannot provide proof of completion of such a course are required to take the "CMAD 495 Foundation Media Research Methods" course in their first semester. Financial Regulations

Students must comply with the financial regulations of the University. Students are expected to settle their tuition and fees as per the payment deadlines.

Payment Deadlines

University students are required to pay their tuition and fees based on the below due dates:

Late Registration

University students must adhere to registration deadlines. Registration of courses must be no later than the last working day before the start of the Add/Drop period. Registration during or after the Add/Drop period is subject to a Late Registration Fee.

Late Payments

University students must adhere to payment deadlines. Payments completed after the deadline for each installment is subject to a Late Payment Fee.

Outstanding Balances

Students with outstanding balances or financial obligations will:

- Not be able to **access the learning management systems**.
- Not be able to **view their grades**.
- Not be eligible to **register** for the following term.
- Not be able to **get transcripts, grades, graduation/completion letters and certifications**.
- Not be able to **obtain Finance approval** required for processing various forms.

Refund Policy

Dropping/Withdrawing from Courses:

In the event a student drops a course during the add/drop period, the student will be refunded 100% of the paid tuition and fees for the course as long as the student maintains the minimum credit hours for the semester. Non-attendance of classes does not imply that the student has dropped the course, and the tuition and fees will be applicable. In the event a student withdraws from a course after the add/drop period, the student will not be refunded for the tuition and fees of the course.

Withdrawing from the Semester/University:

In the event a student chooses to completely withdraw from the university or a semester, the following refund schedule will apply for the tuition and fees excluding the non-refundable fees and deposits:

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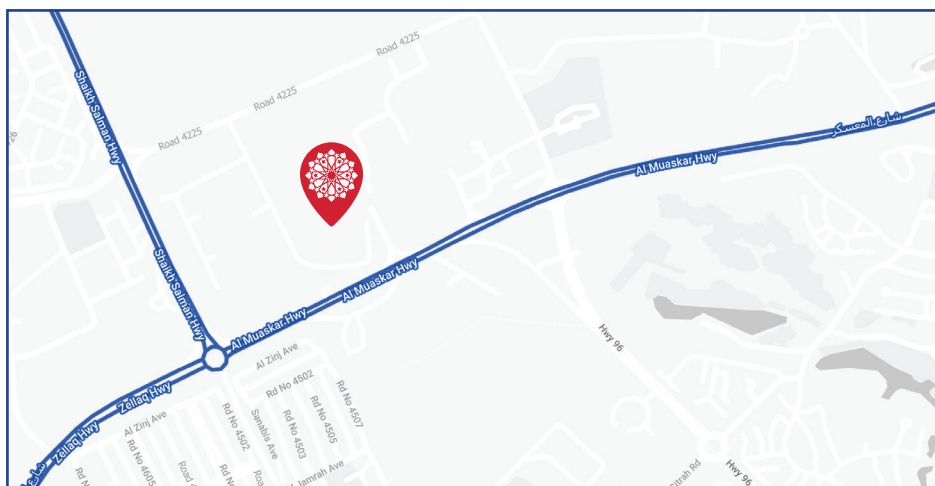
