

The AUBH Scholarship Guide (everything that you need to know)

Scholarship

AUBH grants scholarships to students with exemplary academic performance, personal achievements, and motivation to succeed in an American-style environment. They are also seen as ambassadors of the AUBH mission and vision, who thrive within a diverse and multicultural student body.

To apply for a scholarship, the student must:



Obtain a GPA of 90% and above or equivalent.



Provide all the standard documents required for admission, in addition to a personal portfolio, including evidence of personal and academic achievements.



Score an overall score 6.0 points in the IELTS test, with no less than 5.5 in the writing section and above or equivalent.



Pass the AUBH Problem Solving test and the AUBH Scholarship Panel interview.



Please keep in mind that candidate selection is a selective process due to the large number of scholarship applicants.

The ranking and selection of applicants will be based on the following:



Applicants may be contacted for an interview with a panel to discuss academic performance and personal goals.



The Interview



Punctuality is a must, so make sure be on time for your interview.



While there is no strict dress code, dressing smart would give a positive impression.



The interview might be conducted online or face-to-face.



The duration of the interview is approximately 30 minutes.



The interview will be conducted by a panel of members.



Candidates should provide thorough and detailed responses, offering unique answers and strong examples to support their ideas and claims. Their responses can stem from personal or academic experiences.





The Personal Statement



The statement should be clear, cohesive and concise.



It should reflect your values, future goals and ultimate vision.



It should also explain how your major of choice will support your ambitions.



Ultimately, it should give a clear picture of your personality, interests and professional pursuits.



It should not exceed 1000 words.



The Portfolio

Format requirements:



Slideshow presentation or PDF.



Evidence to support achievements, such as photos, certificates, letters, etc.

The content required:



A brief explanation for each achievement. For example: charity work, MUN involvement, assisting the school, participating in local or international competitions, INJAZ and so forth.




The evidence provided should give a clear indicator of the following:

- What did you achieve?
- What can you offer AUBH?
- What makes you stand out from other applicants?



The Problem-Solving Test

Format requirements:



The Problem-Solving test is conducted online.



The duration of the test is 1.5 hours.



Candidates will be tested on their Math proficiency by solving problems.



General knowledge of Math is needed as students will be required to apply formulas, make calculations and more.
