

## **ARHG 104 Arabic for Arabic Speakers**

A practical language course which aims at developing the language skills of native speakers of Arabic. This course provides the students with a comprehensive knowledge of the linguistic system. It's intended to help learners reach a superior level of proficiency by expanding vocabulary and providing paragraph-level activities in reading, writing, and speaking; through a selection texts by writers from across the Arab world address a literary themes and represent a range of genres, styles, and periods; where each text is followed by exercises that measure understanding and comprehension, vocabulary and language applications, including grammar, morphology, spelling, stylistic applications and composition. - 1. Identify the Arabic texts characteristics.
- 2. Apply, as necessary, Arabic grammar and vocabulary to engage in basic and familiar debates, conversations, and research.
- 3. Utilize, with some guidance, basic Arabic language skills to deal with specific professional, cultural, and social life contexts.
- 4. Communicate through reading, writing, and speaking in Arabic.
