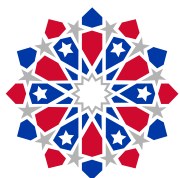

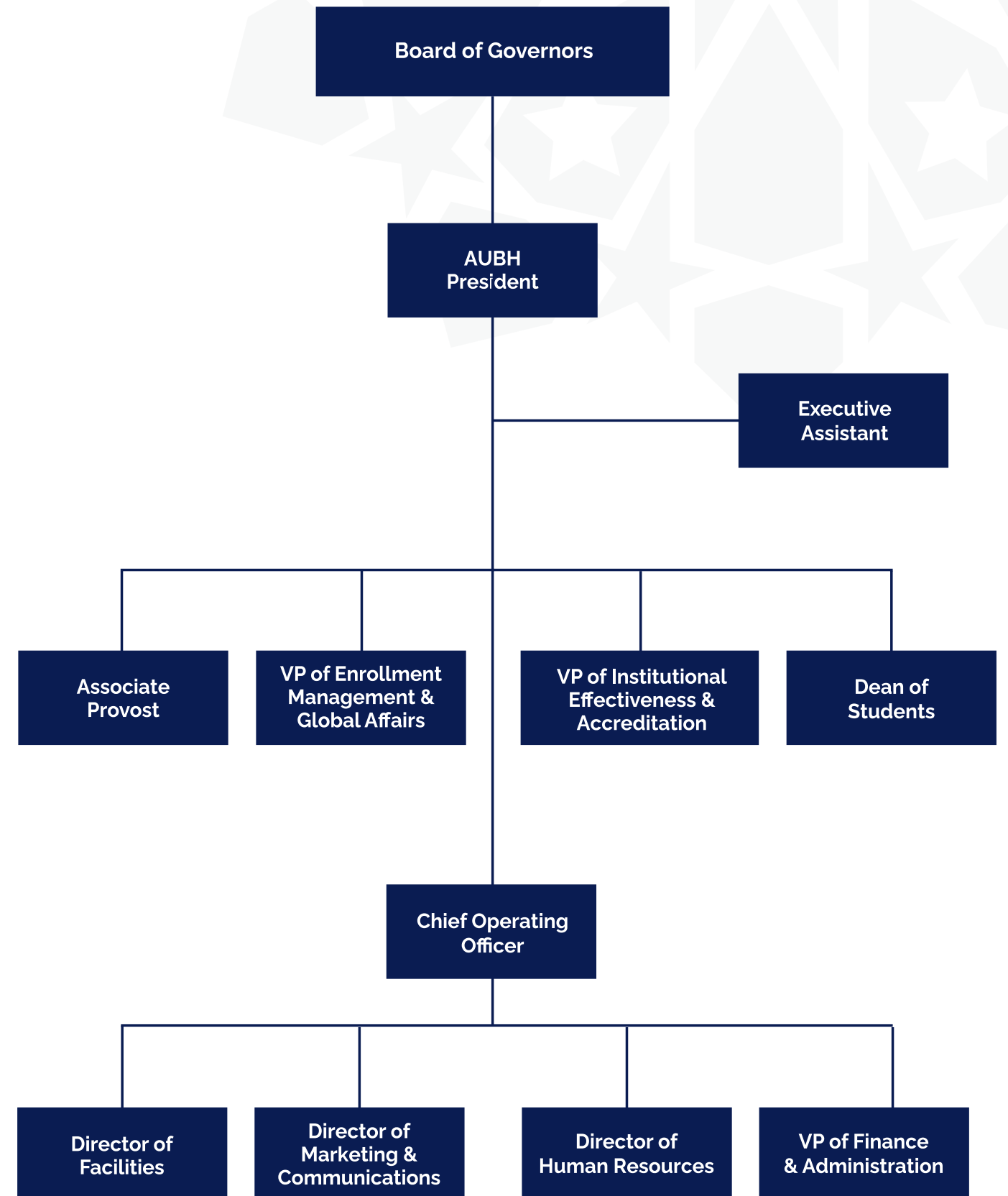
Our Mission

Organizational Chart

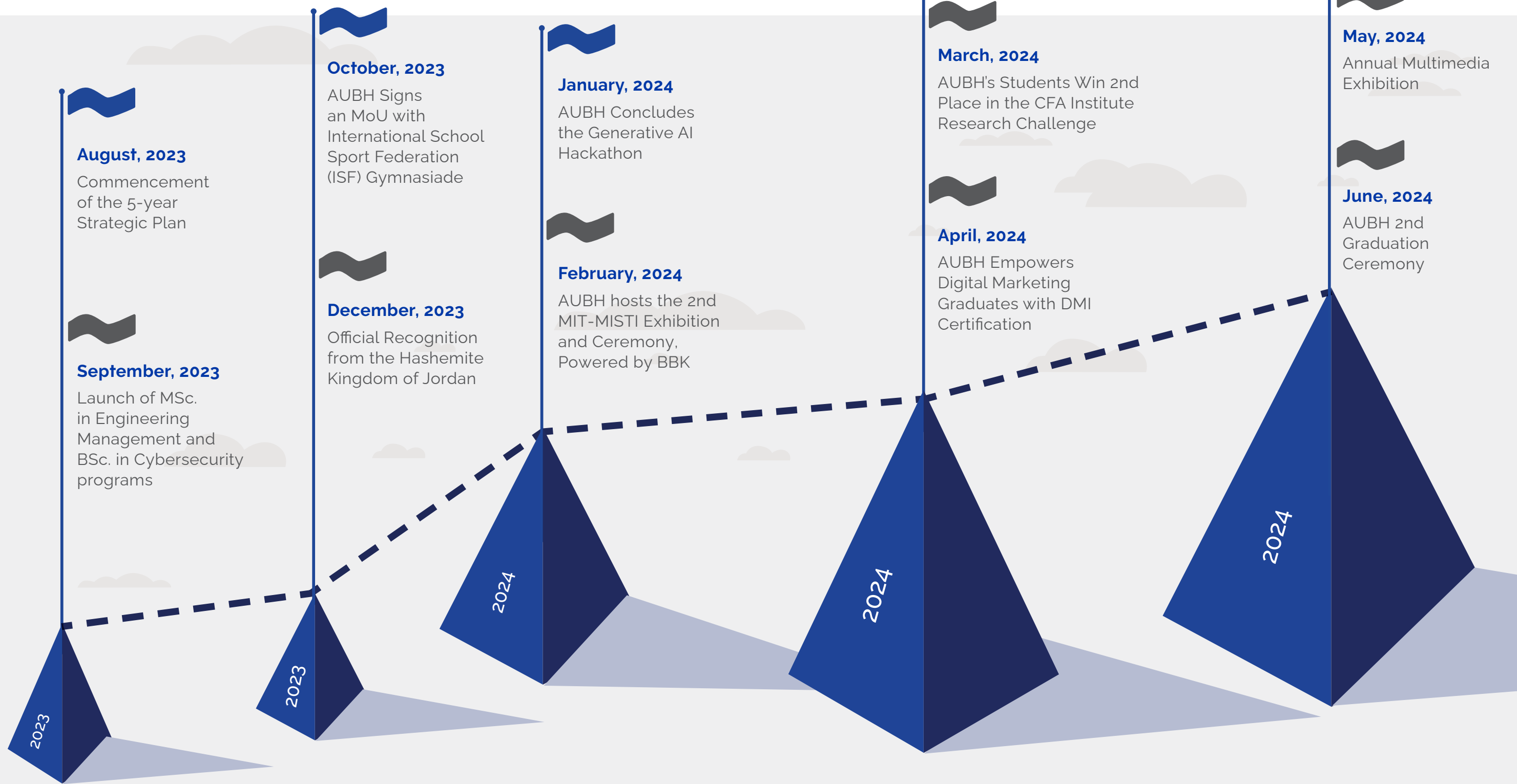

Partnerships & Collaborations



- **CSUN:** The largest external relationship currently in place at AUBH is with the California State University, Northridge (CSUN). The partnership was executed in 2021 with the objective of providing AUBH students with a pathway to finish their degree in the United States at the CSUN campus in Los Angeles, California. AUBH is currently working with CSUN to conduct a formal review of the agreement as it enters into the third year of the partnership to assess whether the value originally intended to be achieved has materialized.
- **Kortext:** A global leader in digital learning solutions, where it will provide students with transformative, flexible, and innovative learning opportunities. Kortext will work closely with the university to create a bespoke online e-bookstore exclusively for AUBH students.
- **NOCN Gulf Skills Consultancy:** A strategic partnership with NOCN Gulf Skills Consultancy will advance education and skills development in the region. It enables international students and diploma holders to pursue higher education at AUBH and promotes vocational education through joint events. The collaboration includes internships, workshops, and industry projects, offering students practical experience and real-world exposure.
- **MIT x AUBH MISTI Workshop Collaboration:** In partnership with MIT's MISTI program and sponsored by Bank of Bahrain and Kuwait, is hosting a workshop on building wearable technology. Students will learn skills in robotics, coding, prototyping, and design, gaining practical experience and insights into emerging technologies.

- **DMI Certification:** AUBH Empowers program graduates of the Bachelor of Business Administration in Digital Marketing and Social Media where they will receive a professional certification from the Digital Marketing Institute in Ireland (DMI) along with their academic degree.
- **PREMO Group:** AUBH partnered with PREMIO Group to support young Bahraini engineering graduates by offering annual international scholarships to two top graduates. This year, Adnan Hashim (Computer Science) and Akbar Saleh (Computer Engineering) will gain global experience, applying their skills in an international setting and exploring diverse cultures, aligning with AUBH's mission to develop well-rounded, world-ready professionals.
- **Tamkeen - CERN:** As part of its Global Ready Talent Program, Tamkeen partnered with AUBH to offer year-long internships at CERN. This year, Mohamed Jaafar (Computer Science) and Noor Abduljalil (Mechanical Engineering) were selected, gaining exposure to cutting-edge science to enhance their skills and prepare for careers in computing, technology, and engineering.
- **McLaren - Mumtalakat Portfolio:** AUBH partnered with McLaren Group to offer one-year internships for graduates in Engineering, Computing, and Business, with potential for permanent roles. Supported by Tamkeen's 'Global Ready Talent' Program, the initiative provides international exposure and hands-on experience in high-tech automotive projects at McLaren's UK headquarters, advancing graduates' global career prospects.

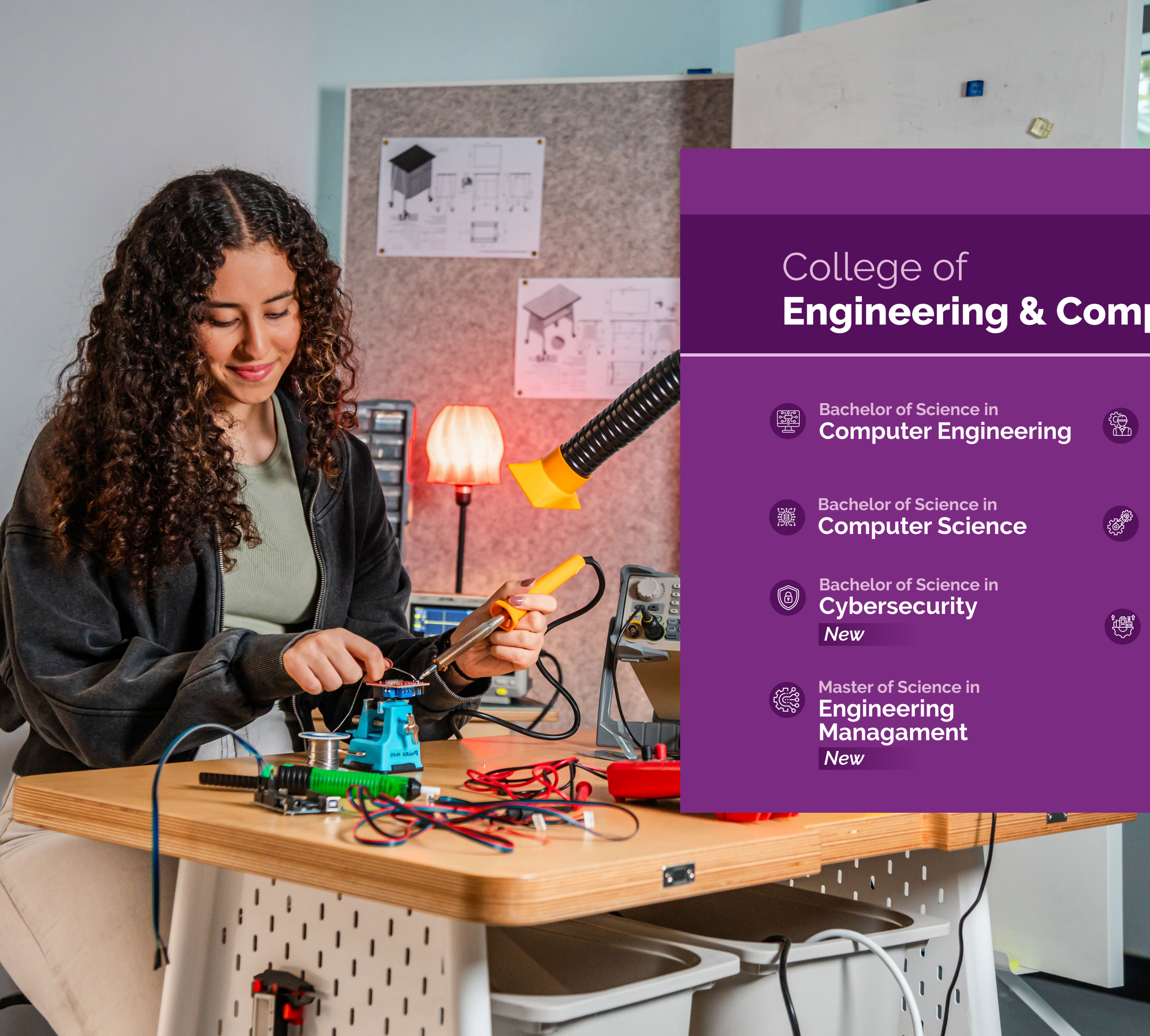

End of Year Awards

By the end of each academic year, faculty members will be recognized for their achievements and hard work through three key awards allocated by the Provost. These awards are given based on a comprehensive rubric, evaluations, and observations.

■ Provost Award

Is the most comprehensive, evaluating all aspects of a faculty member's contributions, including teaching, research, teamwork, workshop attendance, course development, and involvement in accreditation processes.

■ Creative Teaching Award

Focuses on the most crucial aspect of the University—teaching. The award's rubric considers three main factors: end-of-course surveys, student feedback, and lesson observations.

■ Active Researcher Award

Recognizes the research activities of faculty members throughout the academic year, celebrating their dedication to advancing knowledge in their respective fields.

Center for Teaching & Learning Excellency

The Center for Teaching and Learning Excellence (CTLE) is committed to advancing the culture of teaching and learning at AUBH through a wide range of Professional Development (PD) activities, knowledge-sharing sessions, and resources. The CTLE partners with faculty and colleagues across the University to identify (PD) needs and provide support for excellence and innovation in teaching and learning accordingly. The Center understands teaching as a critical practice, driven by inquiry, experimentation, reflection, and collaboration, and promotes pedagogy that is inclusive, learner-centered, and research-based. Also, the purposeful use of new media and emerging technologies in the classroom and online to foster the success of AUBH's instructors and students is key for the Center.

In the 2023-2024 academic year, the CTLE held meetings on a weekly basis with the Vice President of Institutional Research and Assessment to plan for, and discuss, the main operations and progress of the Center. The main action items of these meetings included the coordination of the development of a comprehensive plan of PD activities for the year, the coordination of the AUBH Education Day, and incentives to encourage faculty participation in the Center's PD activities and events.

By the end of 2023-2024, the **CTLE had organized 5 workshops**, two of which were presented by externals, covering a variety of topics such as quality assurance matters (e.g., measurement of learning outcomes; compliance with the National Qualifications Framework (NQF) requirements; etc.), digital literacy and instructional design, and performance-based assessment. This is in addition to organizing 3 roundtable discussions and 5 knowledge-sharing sessions on topics including artificial intelligence, machine learning, qualitative research, and education for diverse learners and their support.

Furthermore, the Center secured membership in the Arab Consortium for Centers of Teaching and Learning (ACTLC), with membership on the ACTLC Board of Governance. The ACTLC is a non-profit collaborative platform for enhancing the quality of teaching and learning practices across the GCC region. The Center also managed to develop a professional development (PD) program for AUBH faculty members through Coursera offerings, that will help enhance the quality of their teaching, learning, and assessment skills and will help them accumulate points toward their academic promotion.

All these activities of the CTLE are strongly aligned with the vision, mission, and values of AUBH and contribute to the achievement of the strategic goals of the University, primarily those within Theme 1 (Student Success) and Theme 2 (Excellence) of the institution's Strategic Plan.



Research Council

The purpose of the Research Council (RC) is to provide guidance to the University regarding the research vision and its implementation. The RC believes that participating in research and scholarly activities will enhance students' learning experience, which is in line with AUBH's vision. The RC actively promoted research and scholarly activities AUBH during the year by undertaking various tasks and initiatives aimed at fostering a culture of research excellence.

By providing resources, providing funding, and recognizing the scholarly achievements of faculty and students, the RC has contributed to the growth and development of research at the University. 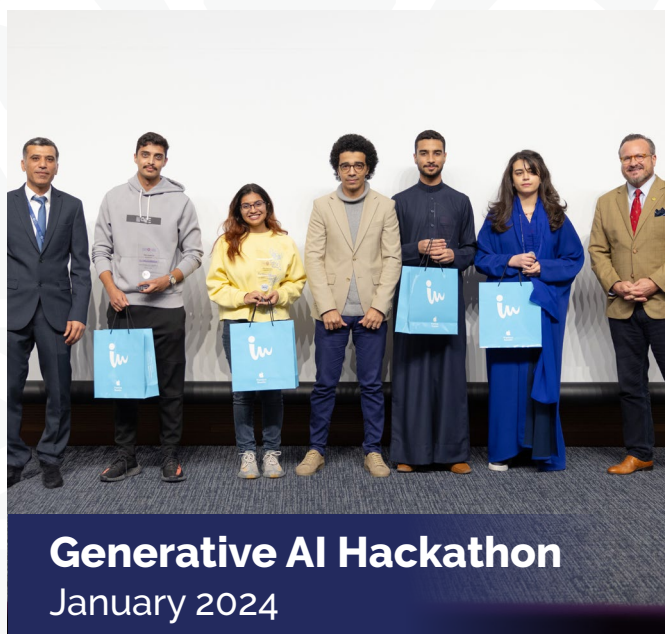

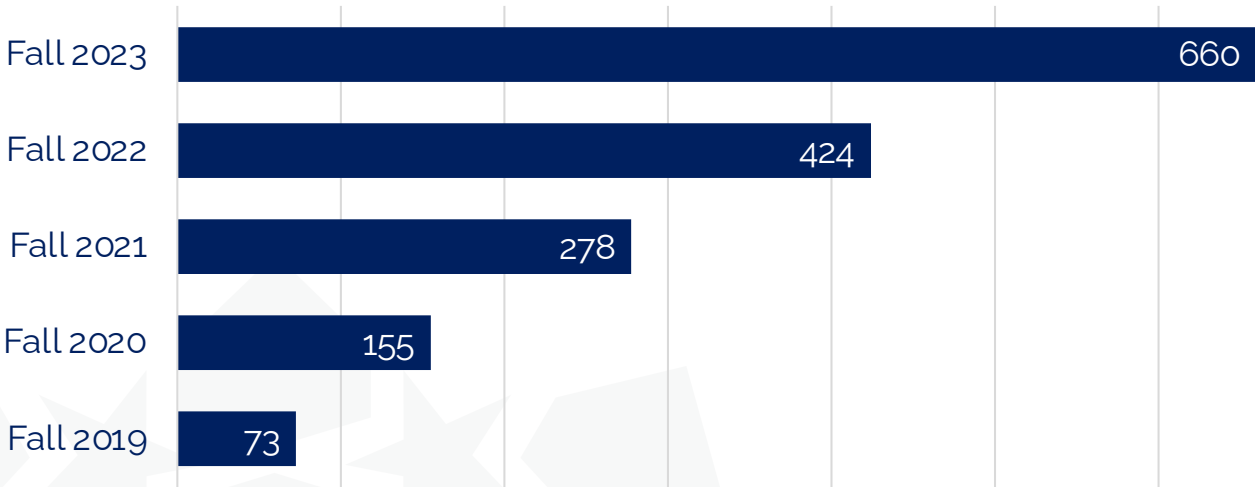

Students' Total Enrollment

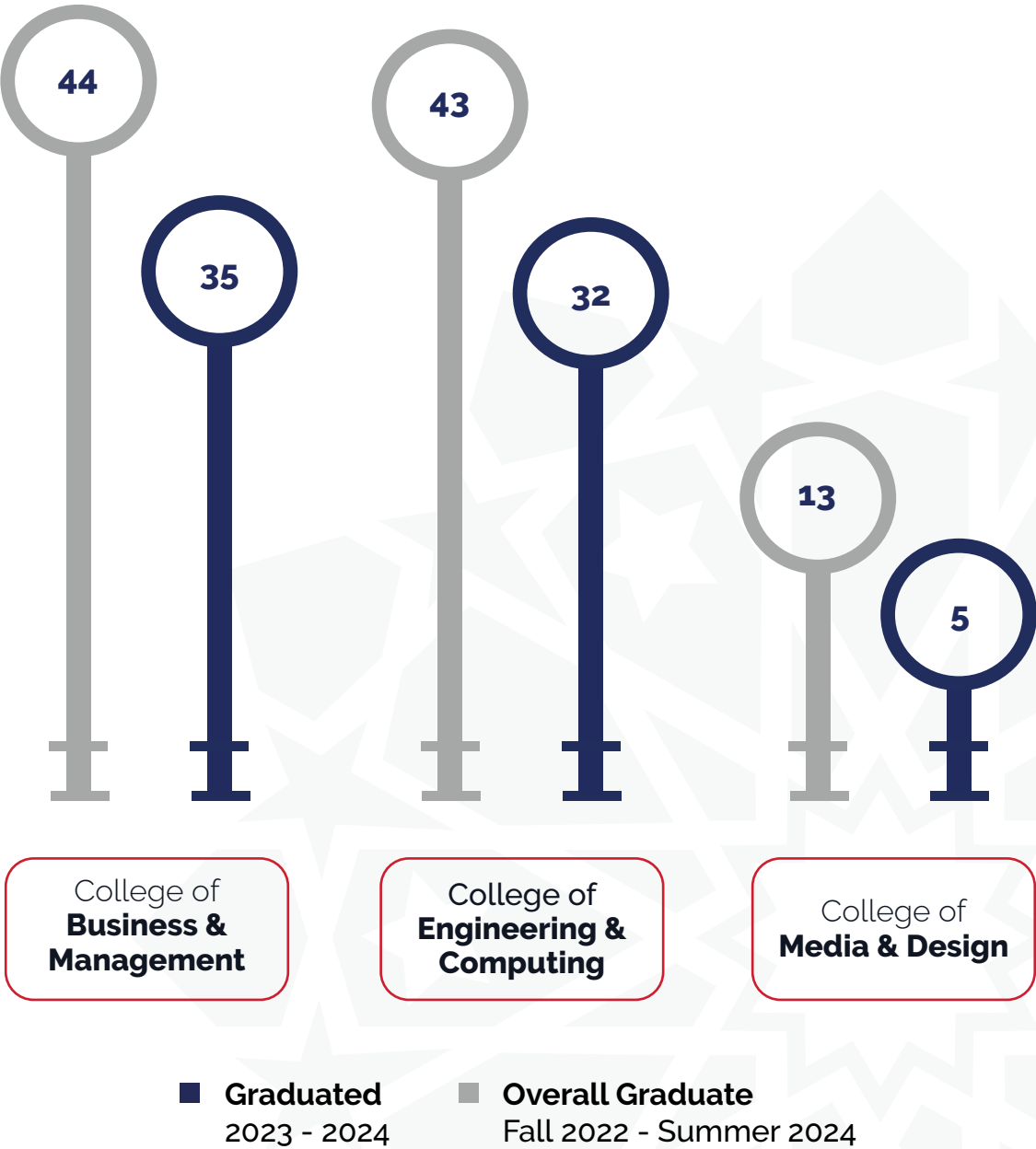

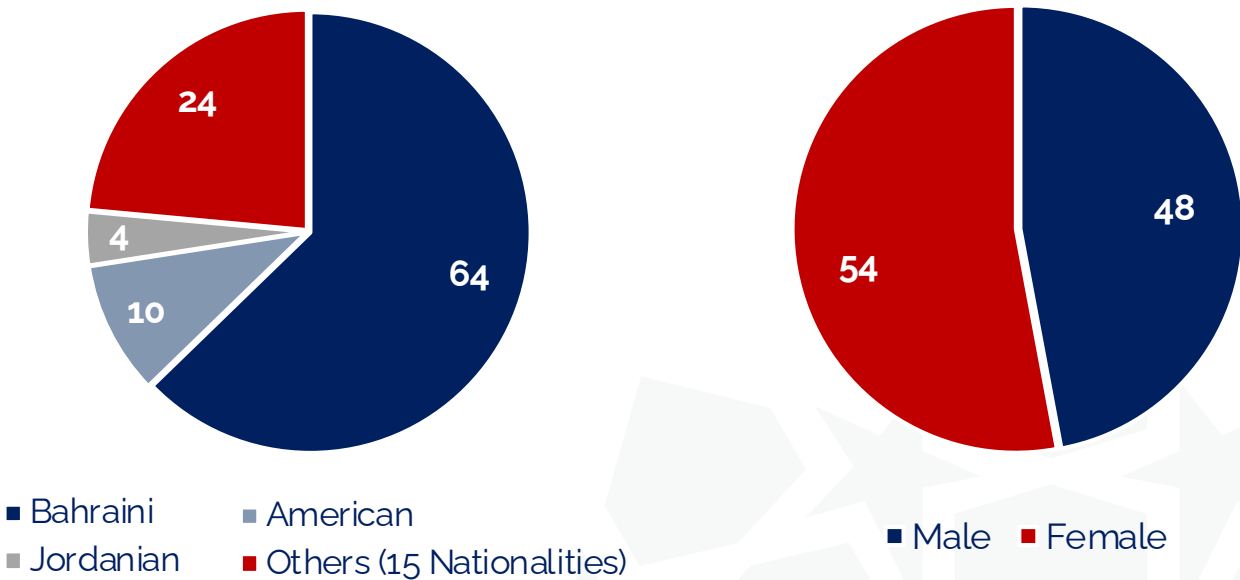
Graduates per College



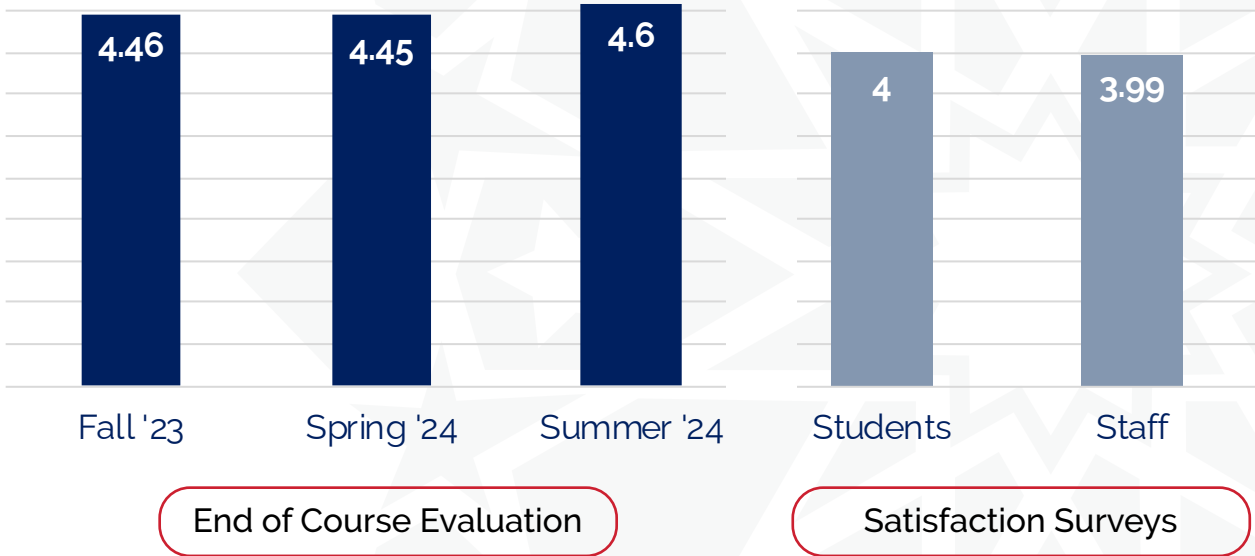
